

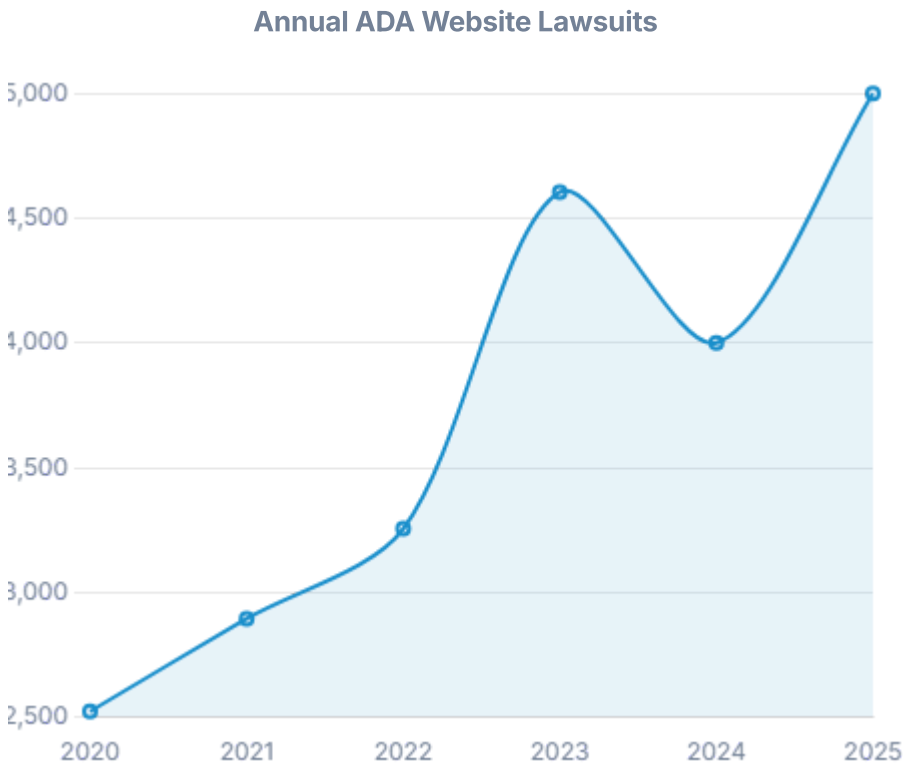

Lawsuits Are Rising

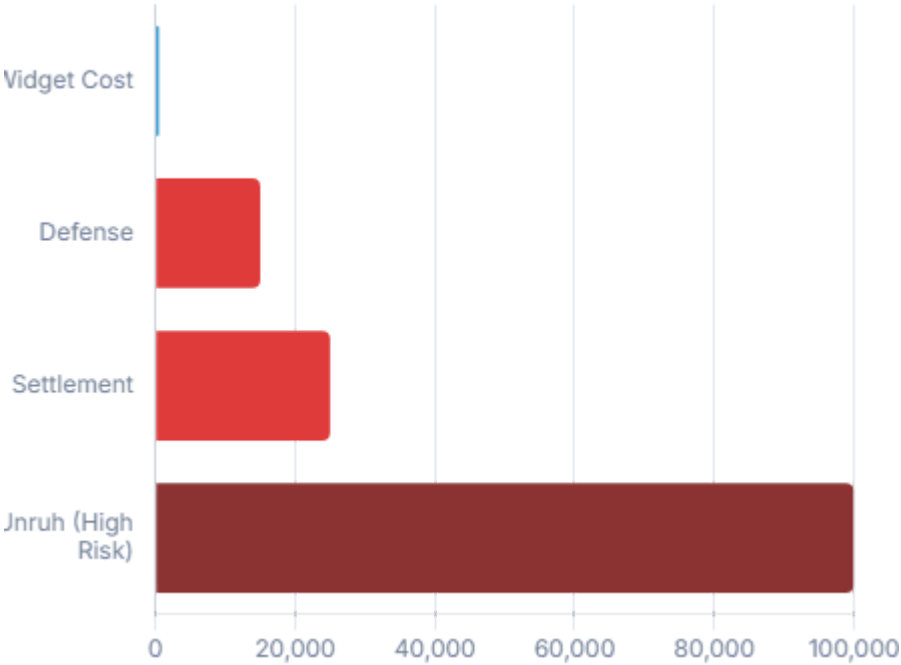
The Myth: Installing a \$49 widget protects you.

The Reality: In 2024, lawsuits hit record highs. Data confirms that **22.6%** of sued websites were using these exact widgets. Courts view them as evidence that you knew about the problem but chose a "cheap patch."



The Real Cost of "Cheap"

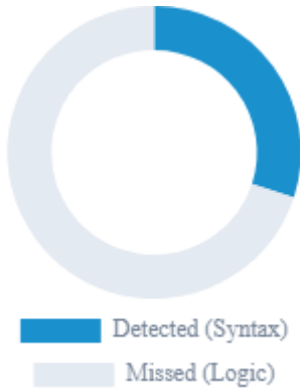
California's Unruh Act allows for statutory damages per visit.



- The Widget (\$490):** Looks cheap, but provides zero legal defense.
- Settlements (\$20k+):** Most businesses settle to avoid trial costs.
- Unruh Damages (\$4k/visit):** Just 25 visits by a plaintiff = \$100,000 liability.

Automation Limits

Tools only catch ~30% of errors.

Common Questions

Do plugins ensure compliance?

No. ADA requires "effective communication." Plugins often fail this standard, leaving you liable.

Does Unruh apply outside CA?

Yes. If you sell to California residents, courts typically rule that you must comply with CA laws.
